

What you need to make a Mooring for your N10 or Sunfish

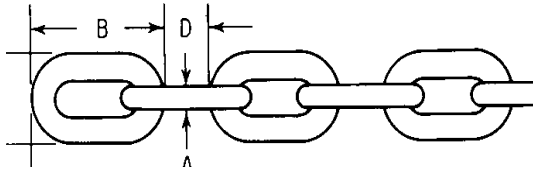
MOORING LINE (ANCHOR LINE)

USE POLYESTER LINE ; (Nylon line is acceptable but doesn't hold a knot as well) (Never use Polypropylene!)

LENGTH: 1/2 " x 50' for Sunfish; 5/8 " x 100' for N-10 (1/2 " will be ok for an N-10 too)

CHAIN: 3/8" zinc galvanized chain

LENGTH: 3 1/2 feet (42 inches or 1.07 meters)

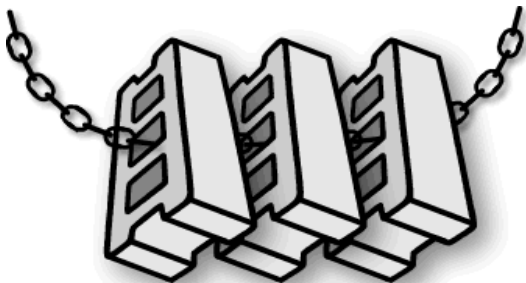


CONNECT MOORING LINE TO CHAIN: One 3/8" Shackle or Swivel



(test to make sure that the shackle fits through the chain)

THE ANCHOR ITSELF: 2 Cinder Blocks (yes, I know that the picture shows 3 blocks,



but we only need 2 Blocks.. I guess that if you really, really want to, you can buy 3 blocks, I'll use the extra one at home.)
